Entry form must be in the IPE office on or before July 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010.

**No late entries accepted.**

All entry forms must be signed in order to validate the entry. Unsigned forms will not be processed. Also entries must be accompanied by full payment of fees.

**SPECIAL ATTENTION:** is called to the General Rules and Regulations printed in the beginning of the Prize List.

Failure to abide by IPE rules listed in the front of this booklet may result in disqualification, forfeiture of prize money and possible disbarment from the fair.

Monday, August 30<sup>th</sup> from 5 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. and Tuesday, August 31<sup>st</sup> from 8 a.m. to 12 noon. You will be given your gate pass when you drop off your exhibits at the **NorVal Sports Centre Park Drive.**

Hall closed during judging - 1 p.m. to 6 p.m.

Tuesday, August 31<sup>st</sup>.

No exhibits to be removed until Monday, September 6<sup>th</sup> or prize money will be forfeited.

**Exhibits and Prize Money to be picked up:**

Monday morning, September 6<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.

**NOTE: ALL Prize monies will be paid upon signature of Exhibitor by the Division committee or at the office. If pickup is not possible please make arrangements with Division chairperson and/or office staff prior to October 2<sup>nd</sup>. AFTER October 1<sup>st</sup> 2010 prize money not claimed will be considered a donation to the Exhibition.**

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

01. Where the word **NAMED** appears, name of **variety must be shown on entry form** or entry will be disqualified.
02. Individual exhibits mailed or expressed to the Exhibition, will be opened and arranged by the management for display in competition.
03. All fruit in classes 1 to 54 inclusive, must be grown by Exhibitor.
04. Fruit will be judged according to the Standards of Perfection as set out in the B.C. Circular #50C. This circular can be obtained from the Ministry in Victoria, or from your local branch of the Ministry of Agriculture.
05. Special Attention is called to the General Rules and Regulations printed in the beginning of the Prize List.
06. One entry only, to be made in each class **except** in the case "**for any other variety**". The awarding of one or more prizes to one Exhibitor in "any other variety" class to be left to the Judge's decision.

**VARIETY, COLLECTION, CATEGORY:**

Example: apples, cooking or dessert named; see Circular 50C, page 8, Season, Quality and Commercial value. Similar considerations will apply in placing other fruit collections.

07. All fruit entered must be grown in 2010 season.

**ENTRY FEE (tax included):** 55 cents per class. Minimum fee of \$1.10 if only one class entered plus Exhibitor Ticket unless current IPE membership held.

**BERRIES**

- 47. Berries, 24 any variety, NAMED raspberries, strawberries, blackberries or 3 clusters of red currants, black currants, gooseberries, blueberries

**NUTS**

(may be from the previous year's crop) casing intact

- 48. 12 Hazelnuts/ Filberts any kind
- 49. 12 Walnuts, any kind
- 50. 12 Almonds any kind
- 51. 12 Nuts any other kind

**BOXED FRUIT**

- 52. 1 tray or cell pack, Red Delicious apples
- 53. 1 box of Pears, NAMED
- 54. 1 box of Plums, NAMED
- 55. 1 box of Peaches, NAMED
- 56. 1 Junior Box or Handi pack, McIntosh

**SPECIALS**

- 57. Best Collection of fruit (bush, vine and tree) shown individually under the rules of the fruit division. This class will be judged on quality and number of kinds exhibited. **Rosette only.**
- 58. Special Exhibit of one plate of McIntosh apples grown by exhibitor, North of Swan Lake. **Rosette only.**
