LATE ENTRY - BEEF CATTLE

Beef Cattle entries sent after Friday, August 9, will be processed as a late entry. After August 9, all class fees will be **DOUBLED.** Late entries close August 17, except for substitutions.

MOVE IN: Contact the Beef Director to schedule, all cattle must be on site by <u>Thursday, August 31, 6:00 pm</u>, all decorations & signage must be in place by 8:00 am Friday. Note that participants in the **PCI Royal Junior Beef Challenge** must have their steers on site by <u>Thursday, August 31, 12:00 pm</u> for afternoon weigh-in.

MOVE OUT: No exhibits or stall displays to be removed until Sunday, September 1 after 6:00 pm with a staggered move out. Removal of either by the exhibitor will result in forfeiture of all prize money.

ENTRY FEE: \$22.00 per class unless otherwise stated plus Exhibitor ticket unless current membership held. Adults & Students: \$26 Child (6 to 12): \$10 Child (5 & under): free Attendants tickets may be issued one (1) per each six (6) head entered

REFUNDS: only with Doctors or Veterinary Certificate turned into the show office prior to the start of the IPE.

Alcohol Consumption: The consumption of alcoholic beverages on IPE premises at any time is strictly prohibited except in designated licensed areas. Persons found consuming alcohol outside of licensed areas will face instant dismissal from this and future shows.

Supplies: Shavings will be made available. Hay will be available for purchase on site, straw will be allowed in the beef aisles of the cattle barns. Stock piling of feed is limited to that which can be stored in the feed alley. NO feed is to be piled in the cross alleys. Exhibitors are required to provide their own

feed boxes & pails.

01. LIABILITY

1.1 **General:** The exhibitor will be solely responsible for any loss, injury or damage done to, occasioned by, caused by, or arising from or indirectly relating to, any animal or article exhibited by the exhibitor, and shall save harmless and indemnify the IPE against all legal or other proceedings in relation to this loss, injury, or damage, in regard thereto.

02. ENTRIES

2.1 **Registration:** All Canadian animals entered in purebred classes must be registered as purebred at the time of entry, in the Association/Breed registry that is operating under and recognized by the Animal Pedigree Act of Canada. Exhibitors must produce the original certificate of registration in the owner's name upon arrival to the breed representative or Beef Director. Exhibited purebred animals from the United States must be registered in the recognized American registry for the breed and need not be registered in Canada but must be Canadian registerable.

A photocopy of the registration certificate must be emailed to beef@armstrongipe.com. Original registration certificate must be presented to appropriate association representative upon arrival at the IPE with exception to calendar year calves, they must be clearly tattooed, and registration applied for. PURSUANT TO CANADIAN RULES, no prize money will be paid unless entry form is complete.

2.2 **Ownership and Leasing:** The exhibitor named must be the registered owner/lessee of each animal listed on that entry form. A copy of the Association Lease papers must be emailed to beef@armstrongipe.com. The breeder of the animal will be the person(s) recorded as such on the registration certificate. An animal owned jointly by more than one individual, firm or institution must be entered in the names of the joint owners. If one (1) of the joint owners is the breeder of the animal, the animal may be entered in a group class requiring bred and owned. Animals jointly owned must be listed on a separate form under the joint owner's names.

2.3 **Maximum Entries:** Maximum of 10 exhibits plus two (2) 4-H calves per breeding unit (excluding Breeder's Herd and Get of Sire classes). Additional 4-H calves will NOT be eligible for Breeders Herd or Get of Sire classes.

2.4 **4-H Registered Heifers:** Registered beef heifers may be shown by entry in the usual manner, in Open Class in the breed provided the heifer is the registered property of the 4-H member. See Rule 2.2.

2.5 Entry Fees: All fees must be included with your completed online entry form. Entries received without entry fees will not be processed. Entry fees will not be refunded after the entry closing day (only exception is clause 2.14).

2.6 Entry forms: All entries must be prepared on forms supplied in clear legible writing, printed or typed. The exhibitor or his duly authorized agent must sign all forms. All registration and qualification certificate numbers must be shown on entry forms, on failure to do this the animal will not be allowed in the judging ring.

2.7 Errors: The IPE is not responsible for any errors contained

in the entry forms. Reasonable efforts will be made by office staff to contact exhibitors prior to entry closing date should any errors be detected.

2.8 **Refusal of Entries:** The IPE reserves the right to refuse any entry for any reason and to return any fee without being liable for compensation. Entry packages and entry fee(s) received after the closing date will be returned subject to clause 2.14.

2.9 **Show Numbers:** Show harness to be worn by the Exhibitor to carry numbers. All entries in livestock classes will be listed in the show catalog and a number will be assigned to each entry. When in the ring exhibitors must wear the show number in the front and back of the harness.

2.10 **Classes:** Classes may be split at the discretion of the Beef Committee when the number exceeds 16.

The top four (4) animals in each split class will return to the ring for final placing. All animals will be listed in each class by age, youngest to oldest. There is no restriction on the number of animals an exhibitor can enter in a show or class (except Breeders Herd where only one (1) entry per exhibitor or breeding unit will be accepted).

2.11 **Cow/Calf Classes:** The heifer calf is eligible to be shown as a single animal in the heifer class and in the cow/calf class as a unit. If the entry is named a division champion or reserve, the heifer calf entry can <u>NOT</u> be shown in the following calf class. Entry fees will NOT be refunded because of this rule. 2.12 **Breeding Unit:** In each classification where, related exhibitors are involved in more than one (1) breeding operation, such operations are considered as one (1) breeding unit In all classes where there is any doubt that more than one (1) breeding unit exists, the interpretation shall be that only one (1) breeding unit exists. The responsibility of proof of separation of breeding units shall rest with the exhibitor(s). For the Premier Breeder Award joint breeders are separate entities. In Get of Sire and Progeny of Dam classes, be sure to give full name and registered numbers of Sire & Dam on entry form at time of

making entries. 2.13 **Space Allotment & Stalling:** The IPE shall have full discretion to dictate & assign stall space. Stalls will be allotted by the Barn Boss with the actual number of cattle brought to the show. Please contact the Beef Director for any specific stalling requirements.

2.14 **Space Limits:** Due to limited space, entries may be limited priority will be given to entries based on online entry date or other proof of delivery. Entry fees will be refunded in full for those herds which we are unable to accommodate.

2.15 **Substitutions:** Substitutions are only permitted within the same class the original entry was placed in and by the same breeding unit. Substitution must be male animal for male, female animal for female. All substitutions must be presented to the BeefCommittee representative of the breed prior to the breed show.

2.16: **Minimum Shows:** For a show to proceed with full prize money, a minimum of three (3) exhibitors and 20 head of registered cattle must be entered and shown. If three (3) exhibitors and less than 20 head but more than 11 head of registered cattle are entered and shown, then the show may

proceed with 50% prize money. If there are less than three (3) exhibitors and less than 12 head of registered cattle, then they must show in the Multi Breed Classes. If Multi Breeds do not achieve minimum show number of three (3) exhibitors and 20 head of cattle entered and shown, then the Multi Breed class may proceed but with reduced prize money.

2.17: **Multiple Entries**: There is no restriction on multiple exhibits in any classes excluding the Breeders Herd and Get of Sire class. These are limited to one entry.

03 JUDGING

3.1 **Show Regulations:** The showing of livestock will be under the jurisdiction of the association which governs that breed of animal. No persons other than judges, the officials and attendants holding animals being exhibited will be allowed in the Show Ring during judging.

3.2 Judge's Decision: The decision of the judges shall be final in all cases. After each section is judged, the judge shall sign all judging sheets in the judging book. The clerk(s) shall see that these sheets are returned to the Show Office as soon as completed.

04 EXHIBITOR MANAGEMENT

4.1 **Tampering with Livestock:** Unethical fitting of livestock entered for competition is prohibited. Unethical fitting will be deemed to consist of any treatment or operation materially altering the structure or natural conformation, colour, of any part of the animal's body, such as the introduction of hair or a hair substitute. Air, liquids, or other substance subcutaneously in any part of the body, surgical operations to correct defects or the performance of any act or operation to exaggerate the natural conformation of the animal are prohibited. Any tampering, altering or abuse may be reported to the Regulation Infraction Database, North American Livestock and Rodeo Managers Association.

4.2 **Clean Up:** All stalls must be cleaned before 8:00 am daily. Exhibitors are requested to keep the aisles and surrounding area clean. When animals are on exhibit, exhibitors or attendants are required to present their livestock in a professional manner. Exhibitors are required to include stall decoration as part of their exhibit so that the exhibits will attract the attention of the public.

4.3 **Clipping Chutes & Tack Boxes:** Clipping or grooming of cattle in the aisles of the barns is prohibited. The Barn Boss will have the full discretion of where the chutes and tack boxes will be located outside the building.

4.4 **Electrical Equipment:** Exhibitors with fans or other electrical equipment are requested to be sure that the equipment has a proper ground (three wires).

4.5 **Arrivals:** No vehicles will be allowed to stay on the grounds during move-in or otherwise. Once the vehicle is unloaded the exhibitor shall move it to the designated off-site parking lot immediately see rule # 3 Parking and Camping.

4.6 **Weighing/ Processing:** Jackpot Steers and Jackpot Heifers on Friday, August 30 at 3:30 pm. Weighing of all livestock is at the discretion of the Beef Committee. Processing of livestock through the scales will be optional except Jackpot steers and Jackpot heifers or those animals required by the Beef Committee. Show cards MUST accompany animals to scales. All substitutions must be presented to the Beef Committee rep of the breed.

4.7 **Identification:** The Beef Committee Breed Reps will be responsible for the confirmation of CCIA tags within their breed and the verification of any tattoo numbers brought into question If the animal is refused entry on that basis, it will not be processed or inspected again and will not be eligible to show, but may remain on display. Corrections or alterations will not be permitted at the show. Please check your tattoos prior to the show to ensure that they are legible and correct. CCIA Tags are mandatory on all Cattle.

Please note: Animals without CCIA TAGS will not be PERMITTED entry onto the IPE grounds.

4.8 **Wash Racks:** For wash rack usage, priority is given to breeds preparing for their shows.

4.9 **Nose Rings:** HUMBUGS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE. All bulls over one (1) year old must have a nose ring. Lead must be on nose ring when leading bulls.

05 AWARDS

5.1 **Ribbons:** The IPE provides first (1st) to third (3rd) place ribbons as well as Grand and Reserve Grand Champion rosettes.

5.2 **Open Ambassador Trophy Buckle:** This Trophy buckle will be awarded to a non-junior Exhibitor who best promotes the Beef industry through personal presentation and friendliness to the public in the cattle barn and through dress, personal presentation and conduct in the Show Ring. Sponsored by Curtis Haworth in Memory of his father Gerry Haworth, **2023 Winner: Devon Erickson**.

5.3 Breeders Herd, Premier Breeder and Exhibitor:

Breeders Herd: For an exhibitor to enter in a Breeders Herd class, both sexes must be represented & entered in another F Class at the exhibition. Limited to one (1) exhibit per exhibitor. **Premier Breeder:** An award presented to the breeder by prefix, having the highest number of points won in individual classes by not more than six (6) animals bred, but not necessarily owned, by the winner. Calculation of Premier Breeder is readily determined in all identified cases from Certificates of Registry, by utilization of the animals prefix.

Premier Exhibitor:An award is presented to the exhibitor/ owner (individual, partnership or institution) having the highest number of points won in individual classes by not more than six (6) animals owned by the exhibitor. This does not limit the number of animals that may be shown.

Premier points will be based on points awarded to the first six (6) places in the Single Breeding Classes on the following basis: 1st: 6 points 2nd: 5 points 3rd: 4 points 4th: 3 points 5th: 2 points 6th: 1 point (Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion do not gain additional points.). In the event of a tie, the exhibitor with the highest placing in the Breeders Herd Class will be declared the winner.

06. CONDUCT

6.1 **Management Rights:** The IPE reserves the right to rule on any point not covered in these rules and make any changes necessary to all lists, catalogs and schedules.

6.2 **Protests and Penalties:** A protest of show procedure or results may be commenced by either the IPE, or an exhibitor. In respect of the show which that exhibitor has entered. An exhibitor may commence a protest by submitting to the IPE Show Office, a written statement of the reasons for the protest along with a \$100 non-refundable deposit, within 24 hours of the respective show time. IPE may initiate a protest without taking any formal steps. The IPE shall investigate all protests and make a decision, which shall be final and binding.

6.3 **Fraudulent Practice:** Any exhibitor, his agent, or any individual who participates in a fraudulent act or who interferes with or shows disrespect to any judge, official, volunteer, staff or public shall be subject to disciplinary action which shall be at the full discretion of the IPE.

6.4 **Dress:** All individuals directly and indirectly associated with the exhibitors are required to be neatly dressed at all times. Exhibitors shall comply with any and all dress requirements by the applicable breed associations.

6.5 **Show Pictures:** Entering the show ring for the taking of pictures during show time is not allowed. The photography curtain and area is the property of the company of contracted photography. The taking of pictures in this area by any other person during show time is not allowed.

BC ANGUS GOLD SHOW RULES

The 2024 Interior Provincial Exhibition Purebred Angus Show will be a BC Angus Gold Show and will be carried out under the rules of the breed association. Rules of special note are:

* Each member province may designate two shows per year as Gold Shows.

* Gold Show entries are open to all members of the Canadian Angus Association.

* Animals competing must have a Canadian Angus Association registration number at time of judging. <u>Note: Unregistered,</u> pending or "applied for" animals will not be awarded points or count towards grant funding.

* Animals born after 2012 must have a CCIA tag or Canadian Angus RFID indicator.

* Any animals with colour products applied to them in a CAA sponsored show will be disqualified from the show and the show deemed ineligible for financial funding support from the Canadian Angus Association.

* The class structure may be determined by the show organizing committee, however it is encouraged that the Canadian Angus Association Gold Show structure be used whenever possible.

* Individual animal points vary depending on the number of entries in the show. Points are awarded to the top six animals in each class or split, division champions and reserve, grand champions and reserve.

* There are no limits on the number of animals that can be exhibited by an individual member.

* Animals competing must have a legible tattoo that complies with the CAA requirements at the time of check-in or they will not be eligible to be shown. All cattle identified as not tattooed or with an incorrect tattoo will be reported to the Canadian Angus Association.
