SPECIAL ATTENTION is called to the **Commitment to Animal Care** and **General Rules & Regulations** printed at the beginning of the prize list. Failure to abide by IPE rules may result in disqualification, forfeiture of prize money and possible disbarment from the Interior Provincial Exhibition.

****NEW**** Division 4 exhibitors must be current members of Horse Council British Columbia, OR carry equivalent membership (i.e. Alberta Equestrian Federation), OR carry a 3rd party liability insurance policy and have the Interior Provincial Exhibition added as additional named insured with proof of certificate sent to the IPE office in advance of the fair. LATE ENTRIES Late entries on approval base only. Office will have final approval. Late fee will be enforced.

<u>REFUNDS</u> Entry fees will only be refunded through the IPE office with either an official Doctors note or Veterinary note for exhibiting animal **PRIOR** to Tuesday, August 27th, 2024.

PARKING/CAMPING PASSES

1. Division 4 exhibitors will be assigned to the Noval Arena camping area located off Adair St.

2. A limit of one (1) RV/trailer and one (1) vehicle per exhibitor. Parking \$8/day per vehicle. Camping \$10/day per trailer. Maximum 5 days. All camping units must be identified with last name of exhibitor, PROMINANTLY displayed.

Unidentified vehicles will be towed at owners expense.
 Blocking fire lane will result in being towed at owners expense.

MOVE IN Exhibits are received on Tues, August 27, 2024

MOVE OUT No exhibits or stall displays to be removed until Sunday, September 1st, at 11pm, on a staggered basis. Exhibitors are invited to stay overnight on Sunday free of charge.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

 Exhibitors are always expected to conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner - any infraction of this rule is to be reported and will be dealt with by the committee in charge.
 Exhibitors are expected to maintain a safe environment, demonstrate ethical care for horses, and exhibit standards of professional behavior always

3. Classes will be run as close to the schedule as possible. The IPE reserves the right to change or modify the order, time schedule, or classes if necessary.

4. Numbers must be displayed while handling anywhere on the ground.

5. NO one under the age of 18 may handle a stallion.

6. IPE reserves the right to disqualify an entry if a gate hold exceeds the time restrictions of the show.

7. Gate holds must be requested at least 10 minutes before start of class and approval drom Director.

8. NO horse is allowed at or directly around the Lighhorse show office.

9. No horses are allowed to be <u>tied to any fence</u> on the IPE grounds.

10. NO pets of any type including dogs.

11. NO private golf carts or other motorized vehicles allowed on IPE grounds.

ANIMAL INFORMATION:

1. Horses age shall date from the 1st of Jan of the year in which they were foaled.

2. Horses must be sound, fit, and healthy, and exhibited with safe and properly fitting harness and equipment.

3. Injured horses may be requested to be removed from the fair grounds at the discretion of the IPE.

4. Any horse that does not appear to have enough training or experience may be asked to stay in the barn.

5. Div 4 Director/IPE management retains the right to dismiss any exhibitor who does not comply. All complaints and inquiries will be made to the Draft Horse committee, (not the IPE office).

Stabling Regulations:

No charge -Standing stalls \$20/day - Draft box stalls *non-refundable

All horses remain stabled on the fair grounds for the duration of the show entered. Failure to comply will result in forfeiture of all prize money.

\$75 per stall deposit upon arrival. Cheque must be dated August 28, 2024

Stall deposit/cleanup fee will \underline{NOT} be refunded if stall is not stripped or if the horse does not attend.

a. Entries will be limited to the number of stalls available. Indicate on entry form which type of stall is needed.

b. Indicate on entry forms any special requests. IPE will make reasonable effort to accommodate special requests but reserves the right to stabling allotments.

c. Removal of stall tags, changing stalls or using stalls for tack room by exhibitor may result in removal from the show, forfeiting entry fees and prize money.

d. Stalls and alleyways to be **cleaned daily before 8:00am** and kept clear all day.

e: IPE will supply sawdust and limited wheelbarrows. Exhibitors are responsble for cleaning their own stalls.

The Al Jenkins Memorial Top Teamster trophy will be presented to an exhibitor at the end of the show.

Juniors

To be 16 years or under as of January 1st 2024. Juniors must be accompanied by an adult in the cart/wagon at all times. The use of ASTM/SEI or BSI approved equestrian helmets are mandatory.

Show Attire

Exhibitors must present themselves with proper show attire based on industry standards.

Hitch classes: recommended men wear a hat, tie, and collared shirt (jacket or vest optional) and women dress semi-formal (no jeans). Gloves are recommended in all driving classes. In Halter classes, exhibitors should dress semi-formal (no jeans). In the Heavy Horse Pull, exhibitors should present in a professional manner and wear collared shirts.

Heavy Horse Hitch Classes

For this show Draft horses will consist of the following breeds: Percheron, Belgian, Clydesdale, Shire, Suffolk Punch, Mules and other breeds at the discretion of the committee.
