ENTRIES CLOSE - Wednesday, August 14th, 2024

SPECIAL ATTENTION is called to the **Commitment to Animal Care** and **General Rules & Regulations** printed at the beginning of the prize list. Failure to abide by IPE rules may result in disqualification, forfeiture of prize money and possible disbarment from the Interior Provincial Exhibition.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

1. ALL EXHIBITORS MUST COMPLY WITH THEIR SPECIFIC BREED CODE OF ETHICS & COMPLY WITH NLID REGULATIONS.

2. All exhibitors must comply with their specific breed rules on show awards. Rules can be viewed at <u>www.holstein.ca</u> & www.jerseycanada.com.

3. All entries must be owned by & registered in the name of the Exhibitor. The registered owner is the Exhibitor.

4. You may substitute ONLY if you have an entry in that class as of entry closing date. Papers must accompany substitute animal. This rule does NOT apply to Super Cow classes, there are NO substitutes allowed in the Super Cow classes.

5. Unless a minimum of 3 Exhibitors & 24 registered animals are entered & shown, half prize monies will be paid out by the IPE.

6. Due to limited space, entries may be limited. Priority will be given to entries based on postmark or other proof of delivery. Entry fees will be refunded in full for those herds which we are unable to accommodate

7. The IPE shall have full discretion to dictate & assign stall space. Stalls will be allotted by the Dairy Director. Any specific stalling requirements contact the Dairy Director.

8. All registration numbers must be shown on entry forms. Failure to do this means the animal will not be allowed in judging ring.

9. Due to amount of entries in a class either over or insufficient entries, classes may be combined/split at the director's discretion.

10. All stalls must be cleaned before 8am each day. No dumping of milk in the wash racks or manure piles. Prize money will be forfeited by the exhibitor if these rules are not obeyed. Exhibitors are required to include stall decoration as part of their exhibit, so that the exhibits will attract the attention of the public.
11. Exhibitors are required to provide their own feed boxes & pails.

12. Stock piling of feed & straw is limited to that which can be stored in the feed alley. NO feed or straw is to be piled in the cross alleys or outside the barns.

13. Failure to abide by IPE rules listed in the front of this book may result in disqualification, forfeiture of prize money & possible disbarment from the fair.

14. Animals less than 90 days old cannot be shown.

15. Classes 1-7 & 21-27 are junior classes only, any milking animals will be moved to the youngest milking classes.

EXHIBITOR MANAGEMENT

Tampering with Livestock: Unethical fitting of livestock entered for competition is prohibited. Unethical fitting will be deemed to consist of any treatment or operation materially altering the structure or natural conformation, colour, of any part of the animal's body, such as the introduction of hair or a hair substitute. Air, liquids, or other substance subcutaneously in any part of the body, surgical operations to correct defects or the performance of any act or operation to exaggerate the natural conformation of the animal are prohibited. Any tampering, altering or abuse may be reported to the Regulation Infraction Database, North American Livestock and Rodeo Managers Association.

Alcohol Consumption: The consumption of alcoholic beverages on IPE premises at any time is strictly prohibited except in designated licensed areas. Persons found consuming alcohol outside of licensed area will face instant dismissal from this and future shows.

Supplies: Shavings will be made available. Hay will be available for purchase on site, straw will be allowed in the beef aisles of the cattle barns. Stock piling of feed is limited to that which can be stored in the feed alley. NO feed is to be piled in the cross alleys. Exhibitors are required to provide their own feed boxes & pails.

LIABILITY

General: The exhibitor will be solely responsible for any loss, injury or damage done to, occasioned by, caused by, or arising from or indirectly relating to, any animal or article exhibited by the exhibitor, and shall save harmless and indemnify the IPE against all legal or other proceedings in relation to this loss, injury, or damage, in regard thereto.

ENTRIES

Registration: All Canadian animals entered in purebred classes must be registered as purebred at the time of entry, in the Association/Breed registry that is operating under and recognized by the Animal Pedigree Act of Canada. Exhibitors must produce the original certificate of registration in the owner's name upon arrival to the identification representative or barn boss. Exhibited purebred animals from the United States must be registered in the recognized American registry for the breed and need not be registered in Canada but must be Canadian registerable.

A photocopy of the registration certificate must accompany the entry form. Original registration certificate must be presented to appropriate association representative upon arrival at the IPE with exception to calendar year calves, they must be clearly tattooed, and registration applied for. Please send in photocopy of application.

PURSUANT TO CANADIAN RULES, if the office does not receive a copy of the application, no prize money will be paid for that animal.

Ownership and Leasing: At the time of submitting the entry form, the exhibitor named must be the registered owner/lessee of each animal listed on that entry form. A copy of the Association Lease papers must accompany the entry form for all leased animals. The breeder of the animal will be the

person(s) recorded as such on the registration certificate. An animal owned jointly by more than one individual, firm or institution must be entered in the names of the joint owners. If one (1) of the joint owners is the breeder of the animal, the animal may be entered in a group class requiring bred and owned. Animals jointly owned must be listed on a separate form under the joint owner's names.

ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 per class unless otherwise stated plus Exhibitor ticket unless current membership held.

Adults & Students: \$26

Child (6 to 12): \$10

Child (5 & under): free

Attendants tickets may be issued one (1) per each six (6) head entered

<u>REFUNDS</u> Entry fees will only be refunded through the IPE office with either an official Doctors note or Veterinary note for exhibiting animal **PRIOR** to Tuesday, August 27th, 2024.

PARKING/CAMPING PASSES

1. Division 2 exhibitors will be assigned to the Wood Avenue camping area..

2. A limit of one (1) RV/trailer and one (1) vehicle per exhibitor. Parking \$8/day per vehicle. Camping \$10/day per trailer. Maximum 5 days. All camping units must be identified with last name of exhibitor, PROMINANTLY displayed.

3. Unidentified vehicles will be towed at owners expense.

4. Blocking fire lane will result in being towed at owners expense.
